Cut the following: Oranges (at least 5 different): 36-2 ½ squares; Reds (at least 3 different): 24-2 ½ squares; Browns (at least 5 different): 36-2 ½ squares; Lights (at least 12 different): 92-2 ½ squares; Red: 1-1 ½. All squares should be cut prior to the workshop. Bring basic sewing supplies and machine.
